Rival Basketball Game Results in a Win for University of Baltimore

BALTIMORE, MD– 03/17/25- University of Baltimore's (UB) men's basketball team defeated Towson University with a score of 82-79 in the annual "Battle of Baltimore" rivalry game. The game took place at Royal Farms Arena in downtown Baltimore, Maryland this past Saturday, March 15th, 2025, with 8,500 fans in attendance.

UB started the game in a deficit until they caught up to their competitors in the second half. Both teams traded the lead throughout the game, making it a nail-biting experience for all. Towson's sophomore guard, Jordan Harris attempted to score a last-minute point for his team, but was ultimately blocked by UB forward Tyrone Jackson. UB's senior guard, Malik Williams, ended up cementing his team's win with a buzzer-beater 3-pointer.

"It feels amazing to hit that shot in front of our fans, especially with everything on the line. We've been working hard all season, and this win feels like a huge accomplishment," said Williams.

UB's victory not only helped with their postseason prospects, but it also marked the team's first win over Towson in three years. UB is ecstatic about their win, but they won't let it distract them from the rest of their season.

"This was a huge win for our program, but we have to stay focused. Malik stepped up in a big way, and I couldn't be prouder of how we fought back in the second half. But the season's not over, and we'll be ready for the next challenge," explained Mike Johnson, UB head coach.
